DRUG-ALLOWED HOMELESS HOUSING COMING TO DOWNTOWN REDMOND

DEMAND THE COUNCIL TO: HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS

City Council recklessly approved the transfer of \$5.5 million public land to Plymouth Housing for the development of a low barrier, drug-permitted homeless building without allowing any public comment.

A 100-unit, low-barrier, drug-allowed homeless building will be built and run by Plymouth Housing. The location is right across the street from Anderson Park, where the Dog Day Care used to be.

Fellow Redmond residents,

A wealthy **NGO** that gives pipes and needles to its tenants has been gifted public land and \$ for developing a drug-allowed homeless building in downtown Redmond without an RFP.

This 100-unit building allows **sex offenders, drug dealers, and drug addicts** but does not allow families and restricts eligibility for seniors and veterans.

Location: 16725 Cleveland Street, Redmond, across the street from Anderson Park, two blocks away from Redmond Elementary School.

The Redmond City Council **rubber stamped** this homeless project **without allowing any public input**. The city is now **withholding critical information and refusing to hold public hearings**. Councilmember Melissa Stuart said, “we’re going to keep going on this...”
